

# The Clague Family

## 7.1 Origins

7.1.1 Five possible roots are given for the name Clague in "Surnames of the Manks" as follows:-

1. from the Gaelic MacLuathog, son of the swift one;
2. from the Gaelic MacLaoghog, son of calf;
3. from the Irish and Manks MacLiaigh, son of the leech or doctor;
4. from the Norse Kleggi, a horse fly; and
5. from the Gaelic Mac Giolla Luaig, the son of the servant of Lughhaigh, a Celtic saint.

The name does not appear to have any connection with the English Clegg.

The name Maqleog is known from a 7th or 8th century Ogham inscription. The names MacClewage and MacCluage are known in 1511, Clevage in 1521, Claige in 1622, Clouge in 1624, Clauge in 1652 and Clague in 1655. Several variations have been recorded since then, including Cluaig, Cloauge, Cluage, Cloiage, Cluag, Claig, Claigue, Cloag and Clage.

The name appears to be spread widely throughout the Island, being least common in Ballaugh, Jurby, Andreas and Bride and the heaviest concentration being in Douglas, Braddan and Marown.

## 7.2 Early Days

7.2.1 The early Clague family were farmers living at a farm known as Ulican situated in the valley of Baldwin in the parish of Braddan. The name Ulican seems to be a diminutive of the Irish *uladh* meaning a tomb, cairn or, later, a penitential station, i.e. a place where a stone altar was erected, usually over the tomb of some saintly person, as a place of devotion. It is not far from Keeill Abban. The farm is no longer in existence being flooded when the Baldwin dam was built.

### 7.3 WILLIAM CLAGUE—1650

7.3.1 William Clague (491) was born circa 1650. He married Ann Cain circa 1675 (the marriage records for Kirk Braddan do not survive prior to 1683). William was buried at Braddan on the 9th February, 1692 (his Will states he died the same day). See 7.4 for details of his descendants.

His Will mentions his wife Anne Cleag als Cain, his heir and eldest son, William, and other children Paul, Christian and Ann. Also mentioned is his sister Joney. The three youngest children are named executors and it is noted that they are all under age, i.e. not yet 16 years old, which agrees with the known baptisms.

7.3.2 Ann Cain (492) was born in circa 1650. After the death of William Clague, she married Patrick Bittle, a witness to William's Will. There would appear to have been no issue of this second marriage as only the children of the first marriage are mentioned in the Decree of Administration issued when Ann died intestate on the 14th of August, 1701. She was buried at Braddan on the 14th of August 1701, the register reading Anne Caine als Bissal. See 7.4 for details of her descendants.

Her Decree of Administration appoints her four children, William, Paul, Christian and Ann, joint administrators with a note that the two eldest are sworn in Court to be faithful to their sisters in the administration of the estate, inferring that the two girls were still under age. A legacy of 2s 6d was allowed to the husband, Patrick Bittle.

7.3.2.1 Patrick Bittle married Ann Clague als Caine. He was buried on the 11th of March, 1711, at Braddan. 7. 2.4

7.3.3 Joney Clague (494) is mentioned in the Will of William Clague as being his sister.

7.4.1 William Clague (450) was born circa 1680. He married Margaret McYlrea at Ballaugh Church on the 15th January 1701/2. William died in 1761 and was buried at Kirk Braddan on the 22nd June 1761. See 7.5 for details of his descendants.

William inherited the family farm on the death of his father, William (491), in February 1691/2. On the 25th January 1726/27, together with his eldest son William, William senior signed a marriage contract with Thomas Kelly and his wife Averick on behalf of their daughter Christian Kelly. It was agreed that William senior was to give half his farm to the young couple with the remaining half to go to them on his death. The following month William senior signed another marriage contract, this time in behalf of his daughter Jane, when she was to marry Robert Lewin of Creg e Cowin, Braddan [her cousin?]. Here he agreed to give the young couple a dowry of £7 to be paid within five years of the marriage.

When William died in June 1761, the marriage contract between his son Robert and Margaret Cowell was published in court and accepted as his last Will and Testament. In this he agreed to give the young couple all his worldly goods.

- 7.4.1.1 Margaret McYlrea (451) was born circa 1670-80, the daughter of Thomas McYlrea and Mary (see Thomas's Will of 1711 which mentions his son-in-law at Oolikan). She married William Clague on the 15th of January, 1701/2, at Ballaugh. She died in January 1724/25. Although she was probably buried at Braddan, her burial is not listed in the Braddan records. However, the date is given in her administration. See 7.5 for details of her descendants.

From her father's Will of 1711, we know that her mother's christian name was Mary, that she had brothers William, Thomas and James and a sister Mary. Her family were probably farming at Balla-ne-Cooley

- 7.4.2 Paul Clague (496) was baptized at Kirk Braddan on the 29th June, 1681. He was mentioned in his father's Will of 1692. There is a burial at Braddan on the 7th of June, 1742, for Paul of Ulican, which would appear to relate to this Paul.
- 7.4.3 Christian Clague (497) was baptized at Kirk Braddan on the 23rd November, 1684. She was mentioned in her father's Will of 1692.
- 7.4.4 Ann Clague (466) was born circa 1690. She was mentioned in her father's Will of 1692. She married Thomas Lewin on the 29th of November, 1724, at Braddan, see Volume II, 16.0.1 . She was buried on the 20th of December, 1761, at Braddan. See Volume II, 16.0.3 for details of her descendants.

- 7.5.1 William Clague (454) was born circa 1703. On the 25th January, 1726/7, together with his father, he signed a marriage contract with Thomas and Averick Kelly and their daughter Christian Kelly, see 11.3.1. The couple married on the 28th of January, at Braddan. William was buried on the 3rd of March, 1737-8, at Braddan. See 7.6 for details of his descendants.
- 7.5.2 Jane Clague (460) was baptized on the 5th May, 1706 at Kirk Braddan. She married Robert Lewn (see Volume II, 16.0.6) of Creg-e-Cowin on the 12th of February, 1726, at Braddan. There is a burial for Jane Lewn als Clague of Creg-y-Corim recorded at Braddan on the 1 of November, 1738. However, this conflicts with recorded baptisms of her children as late as September, 1746. See Volume II, 16.0.6 for details of her descendants.
- 7.5.3 Thomas Clague (462) was baptized on the 21 December 1708 at Kirk Braddan. No other details are available.
- 7.5.4 John Clague (463) was baptized on the 25th July, 1711 at Kirk Braddan. He was dead by 1738. No other details are available.
- 7.5.5 Robert Clague (412) was baptized on the 17th of January, 1712/13, at Braddan. He married Margaret Cowell at Braddan on the 8th February, 1740. He was buried at Onchan on the 13th June, 1786. See 7.7 for details of his descendants.

In 1742, at the time of the baptism of his eldest child, Mary, Robert was stated to be of Ulican Farm, situated in the valley of Baldwin in the parish of Braddan.

In 1770 the family moved when Robert purchased some Intack land, known as John Looney the Coopers land, in Onchan near to Strenaby Farm.

- 7.5.5.1 Margaret Cowle (413) was born circa 1715. She married Robert Clague on the 8th of February, 1740, at Braddan. She died on the 8th of January, 1800, and was buried with husband at Onchan. See 7.7 for details of her descendants.

She was possibly the daughter of Patrick Cowill and Mary.

- 7.5.6 Paul Clague (464) was born circa 1716. He married Alice Cowley on the 24th of April, 1739, at Braddan. Paul seems to have died in the first half of 1800, but so far a burial has not been found. See 7.18 for details of his descendants.

After the marriage the couple appear to have moved to Lezayre where all their children were born. In 1786 Paul and Alice made a Deed of Settlement in favour of each other, excluding their children, in which everything was left to the longer liver to dispose of as they wished. In 1788 this Deed of Settlement was accepted as the Will of Alice. In February of 1789 Paul made a settlement in favour of his daughter, Alice, who was then living with him together with her husband, John Corlett. This settlement was confirmed in January of 1790. In July of 1800 the settlement was accepted as Paul's Will.

- 7.5.6.1 Alice Cowley (115) was born circa 1715. She married Paul Clague on the 24th of April, 1739, at Braddan. She was buried at Lezayre on the 12th of February, 1788, the Deed of Settlement mentioned above was accepted as her Will. See 7.18 for details of her descendants.

- 7.6.1 William Clague (456) was born in approximately 1728. He died in 1758. No other details are available.
- 7.6.2 John Clague (457) was born in approximately 1730. He is known to have been of age in 1755. No other details are available.
- 7.6.3 Margaret Clague (459) was baptized on the 29th of December, 1734, at Braddan. She was buried at Braddan on the 25th of February, 1736-7.
- 7.6.4 Thomas Clague (458) was baptized on the 20th of March, 1736, at Braddan.

- 7.7.1 Mary Clague (414) was baptized on the 21 July, 1742 at Braddan. She married Robert Quine 16th of January, 1768 at Braddan, see Volume III, 22.1.1. See Volume III, 22.2 for details of her descendants.
- 7.7.2 William Clague (415) was baptized on the 5th August, 1744 at Braddan. He is mentioned in his father's Will of 14th February, 1786 so must have been still alive at that time, when he would have been forty-five years old. Several grand-children are mentioned in the Will but none of them appear to be William's. It may be safe to assume that either he was childless or unmarried at that time. No other details are available.
- 7.7.3 Charles Clague (416) was baptized on the 1 January, 1747 at Braddan. He is not mentioned in the wills of his father or his mother so he had probably died by the 14th February, 1786.
- 7.7.4 John Clague (328) was baptized on the 19th March, 1748 at Braddan. He was born at Ulican Farm, Braddan. He married Margaret Cain at Onchan parish church on the 6th February, 1779 in the presence of witnesses named Charles Calvin and John Quale. There were seven children of the marriage. John was left all of his father's lands in 1786, consisting of the Intack lands described above. He must have purchased other land at Strenaby as in 1791 he sold the Intack land to William Quine for £100. John died at the age of eighty and was buried at Onchan on the 5th February, 1828. See 7.8 for details of his descendants.
- 7.7.4.1 Margaret Cain (329) was born circa 1755. She married John Clague on the 6th of February, 1779, at Onchan. See 7.8 for details of her descendants.
- 7.7.5 Margaret Clague (417) was baptized on the 18th May, 1752 at Braddan. She married John Quine on the 8th of April, 1780, at Onchan, see Volume III, 22.4.3. She was appointed sole executrix by her mother in 1800, when she is described as Margaret Quine, alias Clague. See 22.5 for details of her descendants.
- 7.7.6 Paul Clague (418) was baptized on the 3rd August, 1755 at Braddan. He is mentioned in his father's Will, when he is left a Crown. At this time he would be thirty years old and, using the same logic as in above, it would seem that he was childless and possibly unmarried. No other details are available.
- 7.7.7 Robert Clague (419) was baptized on the 9th October, 1757 at Braddan. He is mentioned in his father's Will, when he is left a Crown. He would be twenty-eight years old at this time, and using the same logic as in above, he would appear to be childless at this time. No other details are available.

7.8.1 John Clague (330) was baptized on the 7th of November, 1779, at Onchan. No further details are available.

7.8.2 Robert Clague (210) was baptized at Onchan Parish Church on the 16th June, 1782. He married Catherine Cannell (see Volume V, 3.5.1) at Braddan Church on the 3rd November, 1810, when the witnesses were Robert Lewin and Edward Corkil. Robert Clague died on the 19th September, 1855 at the age of seventy-three and is buried at Lonan. See 7.9 for details of his descendants.

In 1841 Robert had taken a lease on the farm known as Ballaquark in Lonan. This farm consisted of 80 acres, a farmhouse and other cottages. The census of that year shows the family living on the farm. The census of 1851 shows Robert and Catherine were still residing on the farm together with their son-in-law, another Robert Clague (386), their daughter Catherine, son James and grandsons Robert James and John James. The widow Catherin was living on the family famr in 1861.

7.8.3 Margaret Clague (331) was baptized on the 19th of December, 1784, at Onchan. She buried at Onchan on the 18th of September, 1790.

7.8.4 Isabel Clague (332) was baptized on the 21 of October, 1787, at Onchan. No further details are available.

7.8.5 Thomas Clague (333) was baptized on the 12th of April, 1790, at Onchan. He died in the same year.

7.8.6 Thomas Clague (334) was baptized on the 25th of April, 1791, at Onchan.

7.8.7 Daniel Clague (335) was baptized on the 25th of May, 1794, at Onchan. No further details are available.

7.8.8 Elizabeth Clague (336) was baptized on the 12th of November, 1797, at Onchan. No further details are available.

- 7.9.1 John Clague (337) was baptized on the 26th May, 1811 at Braddan. He died on the 13th June, 1811.
- 7.9.2 Robert Clague (48) was baptized on the 7th February, 1813 at Braddan. In 1841 he was living with his parents on the farm at Ballaquark, Lonan. He married Isabella Killip (see Volume III, 20.6.3) at Lonan parish church on Saturday the 16th December, 1843. The witnesses were Thomas McKeale and J.W. Kerruish. At this time the new Parish Registers had not long been in use and the Vicar, the Reverend Joseph Qualtrough, often added extra details. In the case of Robert and Isabella he said that they were in good circumstances". Robert is described as a Farmer aged thirty (which agrees with the details of his baptism) and Isabella is described as a farmers daughter, aged twenty-six, the daughter of Patrick Killip".
- It would appear that much of Robert's early life was spent on his parents' farm, Strenaby Farm in Abbeylands, Ballaquark. By 1851 they had set up home in a cottage on the farm. When Robert's father died in 1855 Robert took over the farm lease and the family settled here for over twenty years. The 1861 census shows the family living on the farm. By 1881 they had moved out to a cottage on the Glen Road where Robert spent his retirement. Robert died on the 13th June, 1882, aged sixty-nine, and was buried at Lonan on the 15th of June. See 7.10 for details of his descendants.
- 7.9.3 John Clague (338) was baptized on the 4th May, 1816 at Braddan. In 1841 he was living, unmarried, on the family farm at Ballaquark, Lonan. He married Ellen Killip (see Volume III, 20.6.4) on the 10th of November, 1842, at Lonan. The 1851 census shows him employed as a miner and living with his family in Laxey Glen. He was buried on the 18th of July, 1866, at Lonan. See 7.14 for details of his descendants.
- 7.9.4 Margaret Clague (339) was born circa 1818, though no record of her birth or baptism have yet been found. In 1841 she was living with her parents at Ballaquark, Lonan. She married John Kermode on the 16th of October, 1841, at Lonan. See 7.16 for details of her descendants.
- 7.9.4.1 John Kermode (340) was born circa 1811 at Lonan. He married Margart Clague on the 16th of October, 1841, at Lonan. A miner, in 1851 he and his family were living at GretchVeg, Lonan. See 7.16 for details of his descendants.
- 7.9.5 Thomas Clague (341) was baptized on the 16th September, 1822 and died on the 25th September, 1822.
- 7.9.6 Thomas Clague (342) was baptized on the 23rd November, 1823 at Braddan. He has not been identified in the 1841 census.
- 7.9.7 Catherine Clague (343) was baptized on the 26th June, 1825 at Braddan. She married James Robert Clague on the 21st of October, 1848, at Lonan when her age was recorded as 22 years. See 7.20 for details of her descendants.
- In 1841 she was living with her parents at Ballaquark, Lonan.
- 7.9.8 James Clague (345) was baptized on the 3rd of August, 1828, at Braddan. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Ballaquark, Lonan. In 1851 he was living on the family farm at Ballaquark. He has not been identified in the 1861 census.

7.10.1 Isabella Catherine Clague (47) was baptized on the 20th of April, 1845 at Lonan. She married Philip Kinrade (see Volume III, ) on the 18th of October, 1879 at Braddan. She was buried at Braddan on the 30th of March, 1918. See Volume III, 1.19, for details of her descendants.

In 1851-71 she was living with her parents at Ballaquark, Lonan. Isabella gave birth to two sons, Alfred Clague and John Robert Clague, before her marriage to Philip Kinrade. In 1881 she and her husband were living on Gretch Voar, Lonan. In 1891 she was keeping a boarding house at 8, Windsor Road, Douglas. In 1901 she was living at 15, Richmond Grove, Douglas, with six of her unmarried children. Living with the family was a Margaret Clague aged 46 of Lonan, described as a married aunt, and William Clague aged 12 of Liverpool, described as a cousin.

7.10.1.1 Alfred Clague (169) was born in 1867. A record of his birth has not been traced, but he appears in the census of 1871 and 1881 when he was living with his grandparents Robert Clague and Isabella Killip. In the 1881 census he is recorded as their son rather than as their grandson. This must be an enumerators mistake. He is known to have spent many of his early years living with his grandparents. As a young man he lived in Douglas with his aunt Emily Clague (166) or the Hoggs. It is interesting that the 1871 census records Theophilus and Catherine Hogg visiting with Robert and Isabella Clague. Alfred is also present, aged three years. Are these the Hoggs he eventually lived with in Douglas?

He left the Island with his step-father, William Kinrade, for the gold mines in South Africa. This appears to have been around 1890 as neither he nor William appear in the 1891 census. After the death of William, Alfred became quite wealthy. It was around this time that a rift or feud developed within the family. A veil of silence surrounded his name. He was never mentioned by his Kinrade half brothers and sisters. As in so many family feuds, the exact reasons are lost. However, it is noticeable that while Alfred was himself quite wealthy, his mother was left in very reduced circumstance to bring up the surviving children. He returned to the Isle of Man where he is known to have married and to have had two sons, Stuart Clague (283) and Douglas Clague (284). Each of the sons is also known to have married and each to have had a son and daughter.

7.10.1.2 John Robert Clague (170) was born circa 1875. (The IGI shows a marriage between John Clague and Isabella Clague on the 22nd of February, 1876 at Braddan. This entry has not been checked and may refer to a baptism.) In the census of 1881 and 1891 he is shown as John R. Kinrade, son of Philip Kinrade and Isabella Clague. In 1901 he was living with his widowed mother at 15, Richmond Grove, and was employed as a grocer's carter. Throughout his adult life he apparently used the name Kinrade, though he is thought to have signed with the surname Cottier on occasion. This may be a hint as to his father. He died unmarried and without issue.

7.10.2 Catherine Clague (216) was baptized on the 12th December, 1846 at Lonan. In 1861 she was living with her parents at Ballaquark, Lonan. She married Theophilus

Hogg on the 18th of March, 1871, at Lonan (see Volume III, 19.10.1). See Volume III, 19.11 for details of her descendants.

- 7.10.3 Sophia Jane Clague (113) was baptized on the 10th of January, 1849, at Lonan. She was known as Ashie. In the censuses of 1851—71 she was living with her parents at Ballaquark, Lonan.
- 7.10.4 Robert Stephen Clague (174) was baptized on 5th January, 1851 at Lonan. In 1861 and 1871 he was living with his parents at Ballaquark, Lonan. He married Charlotte Comaish on the 17th of August, 1878, at Maughold. In 1881 he and his family were living at Kion-ne-Kinnin, Maughold, where Robert was employed as a farm servant. In 1891 the family were living at Ballagorey Old Farm where Robert was employed as an agricultural labourer. See 7.11 for details of his descendants.
- 7.10.4.1 Charlotte Comaish (175) was born circa 1855, at Maughold. She married Robert Stephen Clague on the 17th of August, 1878, at Maughold. See 7.11 for details of her descendants.
- 7.10.5 Margaret Matilda Clague (426) was baptized on 9th April, 1853 at Lonan. In 1861 and 1871 she was living with her parents at Ballaquark, Lonan.
- 7.10.6 Rebecca Anne Clague (346) was baptized on the 19th April, 1861 at Lonan. She died on 24th April, 1861.

- 7.11.1 Robert Stephen Clague (176) was born circa 1876. He was living with his parents in Maughold at the census of 1881 and 1891. He was buried at Maughold on the 15th of June, 1896, when his age was recorded as 23 years.
- 7.11.2 James Alfred Clague (177) was born on the 25th of July, 1879, at Maughold. He was living with his parents in Maughold at the census of 1881 and 1891. He is known to have married and to have had three children. No other details are available.
- 7.11.3 Katrine Margaret Clague (114) was born on 13th of August, 1881, at Maughold. She was living with her parents in 1891. In 1901 she was living with her parents at Corony Bridge, Maughold. She had four children before she married John Thomas Kerruish on the 3rd of November, 1907, at St. George, Douglas. See 7.12 and 7.13 for details of her descendants.
- 7.11.3.1 John Thomas Kerruish (181) was born ca 1881. He married Katrine Margaret Clague on the 3rd of November, 1907, at St. George, Douglas. See 7.13 for details of his descendants.

- 7.11.4 Stephen Clague (1030) was born on the 25th of April, 1883, at Maughold. He did not survive infancy and was buried, aged 3 weeks, on the 18th of May.
