

Lonan

4.1 Description

- 4.1.1 The parish of Lonan is situated on the eastern side of the Island, approximately mid-way between Douglas and Ramsey. It is part of Garff Sheading and until 1769 was included in the South Side division but is now in the North Side division.

The main centre of habitation is Laxey. Originally a fishing village, Old Laxey is situated at the mouth of the Laxey River. Mining for lead, silver and copper has been carried out at Laxey from early times. Records are scarce for the early years but there is documentary evidence that lead was supplied from the Island for the roofing of castles built by Edward I in Wales during the thirteenth century. The heyday of mining at Laxey was during the period 1860-90. It has been estimated that around 300 persons were employed at the Laxey mines in 1850, rising to approximately 400 by 1890. There was then a steady decline until the mines closed in 1929. As the mines declined many of the miners went to South Africa and North America in search of work.

4.2 Background

- 4.2.1 This chapter follows the Lonan branch of the Lawson family. So far it has not been possible to make a confirmed connection between this branch and the main family, however, it seems more than likely that a connection is just waiting to be discovered.

We know that Robert Lawson (619) was the son of James Lawson and Isabel Cowle. He was born circa 1605, most probably in Ramsey (Maughold parish). Details of his life have not yet been verified, but he is thought to have married circa 1630 (he was named as an unmarried son in his mother's Will of January, 1627-8).

The first Lawson at Lonan of whom we have definite knowledge is John Lawson (1184), the miller. While it is possible that John was the son of Robert, it seems more likely that he was a grandson.

- 4.2.2 In 1702 the Court proceedings for Garff Sheading (which covered the parishes of Conchan, Lonan and Maughold) records that “John Lawson petitions to have a fine remitted. Granted him.”. It is likely that John was the miller.

The Sheading Court of 27th May, 1706, fined Elizabeth Lawson 6d for public disorder. The entry is written in latin and appears to be a standardized citation: “Elizabeth Lawson vi et armis in et super Ellen Carren insult et affraia fecit et sanguin ab ea extraxit ponit se vi”. Elizabeth Lawson insulted Ellen Carren, caused an afray and drew blood.

At the Garff Sheading Court of the 10th of October, 1706, “They (the jury) present Robert Lawson for killing salmon in the winter season iiis iiiid”. Robert the salmon killer could be the father, the son or the brother of John the miller, there is no indication of ages in the records. However, it seems likely that John the miller did not marry until circa 1700, so the ‘salmon killer’ could not be his son. It is quite likely that Robert, the salmon killer, was the father of John.

4.3 Early Days, a Working Hypothesis

- 4.3.1 Robert Lawson (619) had a son, Robert (1183) born circa 1640, mother not yet identified. Robert Lawson (1183) had a son, John (1184) born circa 1670, mother not yet identified.

- 4.3.2 John Lawson (1184) was born circa 1671. He is believed to have been the grandson of Robert Lawson (619). In March of 1697 he purchased a parcel of Intack Land from Daniel & Catherine Clague for fourteen shillings. He married Elizabeth Corrin circa 1700. He was the miller at Lonan and was buried on the 20th of April, 1721. His death is noted in the Archdeacon’s Register for October, 1721, but there was no Will. See 4.4 for details of his descendants.

The Slander jury of 1710 records: “Elinor Coane, Elizabeth Lawson for saying ...out of the mill ...” indicating that Elizabeth was the wife of the miller, i.e. John Lawson. This court extract has not yet been seen by the author.

- 4.3.2.1 Elizabeth Corrin (1185) was born circa 1671. She married John Lawson (1184) circa 1700. Her christian name is known from the court records, see above, but her surname has not been positively identified. She was buried at Lonan on the 28th of November, 1740. See 4.4 for details of her descendants.

- 4.4.1 Isabel Lawson (1186) was born circa 1700 at Lonan. A son, Philip (1014) by Daniel Eastean (2018), was baptized on the 24th of July, 1726, at Lonan. She married James Kelly on the 4th of July, 1741, at Lonan. She was buried on the 23rd of January, 1756, at Lonan.

Two Wills have been found. The first in favour of her husband was deemed to have been made under duress and was disallowed. The second, in favour of her brother William, was probated by the Court.

4.4.1.1 James Kelly (1374) was born circa 1700. He married Isabel Lawson on the 4th of July, 1741, at Lonan.

4.4.2 Robert Lawson (1187) was born circa 1702 at Lonan. A miller, he was buried on the 20th of March, 1740-1, apparently unmarried and without issue.

4.4.3 James Lawson (1817) was born circa 1703 at Lonan. James possibly moved to Ireland [Kathryn Holt] where he married, though the name of his wife has not yet been determined. He was alive in November, 1740, at the death of his mother but probably died before 1756. See 4.5 for details of his descendants.

4.4.4 William Lawson (1188) was born circa 1705 at Lonan. He married Jane Costean alias Skillicorn (see Volume V, 10.2.1) on the 27th of September, 1735, at Braddan. He was left 6d in his mother's Will and he entered a claim for £1-1s-0d. After a dispute he was named executor of his sister in 1756. He died in 1791, being buried at Lonan on the 4th of May. See 4.7 for details of his descendants.

- 4.7.1 John Lawson (1376) was baptized on the 3rd of October, 1736, at Lonan. He married Ann Fargher on the 27th of January, 1759 at Lonan. He was buried at Lonan on the 6th of December, 1769. (Note: his Will records that he died 7th of December. The burial register is probably more accurate.) See 4.8 for details of his descendants.

- 4.7.1.1 Ann Fargher (1380) was born circa 1734, probably at Lonan. She married John Lawson on the 27th of January, 1759, at Lonan. She survived her husband. See 4.8 for details of her descendants.

- 4.7.2 Robert Lawson (1377) was baptized on the 12th of March, 1738-9, at Lonan. He married Joney Kermod in 1771 at Lonan. He was buried at Lonan on the 19th of November, 1818. See 4.10 for details of his descendants.

- 4.7.2.1 Joney Kermod (1381) was born circa 1745, probably at Lonan. She married Robert Lawson in 1771 at Lonan. She was buried at Lonan on the 7th of April, 1790. See 4.10 for details of her descendants.

- 4.7.3 William Lawson (1378) was baptized on the 25th of January, 1741-2, at Lonan. He married Isabella Skillicorn (see Volume V, 1012.1) circa 1771 at Lonan. He was buried on the 7th of December, 1817, at Lonan. See 4.31 for details of his descendants.

William died intestate in 1817 but it was not until 1819 that Isabella petitioned to have his estate probated.

- 4.8.2 Jane Lawson (1384) was baptized on the 2nd of September, 1764, at Lonan. She received 15 shillings from her father's Will in 1769. She married William Wall on the 21st of January, 1790, at Braddan. She was buried at Braddan on the 14th of

- 4.10.1 John Lawson (1385) was baptized on the 4th of October, 1772, at Lonan. A weaver, he married Jane Cubbon (1400) on the 23rd of December, 1794, at Lonan. He was buried at Lonan on the 7th of January, 1833. See 4.11 for details of his descendants.

- 4.10.1.1 Jane Cubbon (1400) was born circa 1775. She married John Lawson (1385) on the 23rd of December, 1794, at Lonan. See 4.11 for details of her descendants.

- 4.10.2 Jane Lawson (1386) was baptized on the 5th of July, 1778, at Lonan.

- 4.10.3 Robert Lawson (1387) was baptized on the 5th of March, 1780, at Lonan. A miner, he married Jane Casement on the 20th of May, 1809, at Lonan. He was buried on the 3rd of December, 1822, at Lonan. See 4.18 for details of his descendants.

- 4.10.3.1 Jane Casement (1401) was born in 1784. She married firstly Robert Lawson on the 20th of May, 1809, at Lonan and secondly Thomas Walton on the 8th of September, 1827, also at Lonan. In 1841 she was living with her second husband and their families in Laxey. In 1851 her name was recorded as Lawson. As head of household she was living in Laxey with her son Robert and his family. In 1861 her name is once again recorded as Walton and she was living with her eldest son, Robert, and his family in Laxey. She was buried at Lonan on the 23rd of March, 1866. See 4.18 for details of her descendants.

- 4.10.3.2 Thomas Walton (5550) was born circa 1785, in England. The name of his first wife has not been determined. He married secondly Jane Lawson alias Casement on the 8th of September, 1827, at Lonan. He either died or left the Island with his two sons, Thomas and William, before the census of 1851. There is a burial for Thomas Walton aged 59 on the 21st of May, 1843, at Lonan.

- 4.10.4 Joney Lawson (1388) was baptized on the 10th of August, 1783, at Lonan.

4.10.5 James Lawson (1389) was baptized on the 9th of September, 1784 at Lonan. He married Esther Kneen on the 21st of November, 1807, at Lonan. The couple appear to have moved to Douglas after their marriage as all their children were baptized at St. George's. There is a possible burial at Braddan on the 14th of August, 1820. See 5.28 for details of his descendants.

4.10.5.I Esther Kneen (2020) was born circa 1785. She married James Lawson on the 21st of November, 1807, at Lonan. See 5.28 for details of her descendants. There is a possible MI at Braddan (Old Yard South 214) which give a date of death as 2 March, 1869, aged 86. Her name appears among various Lewin names.

4.II.I Jane Lawson (1407) was baptized on the 14th of September, 1795, at Lonan. She married James Kaighan on the 4th of November, 1821, at Braddan. Received 1/- in her father's Will of 1833.

4.II.I.I John/James Kaighan (1417) was born circa 1795. He married Jane Lawson on the 4th of November, 1821, at Braddan. Possible burial at Braddan on the 10th of Decmeber, 1879, aged 83.

In 1841 John Keggeen, a joiner, and his family were living in Society Lane, Douglas. In 1851, as James, he was living with his wife and son James at 20, Shaw's Brow, when his age was recorded as 55 years. In 1861, as James Kaggen, he and his wife were living at 34, Fort Street. He was employed as an house carpenter and his age was recorded as 60 years. In 1871 he and his wife were living at 20, Wellington Street when his age was recorded as 73 years

4.II.2 Judith Lawson (1408) was baptized on the 14th of July, 1799, at Lonan. She married Thomas Corlett on the 21st of July, 1827, at Lonan. She was named execturix in her father's Will of 1833. In 1841 she was living at Laxey Glen with her two children. In 1851 she is living at Reyn Cell, Lonan, with her unmarried son and is described as a widow, aged 50. She is not found in the 1861 or 1871 census, though she seemed to have been buried at Lonan on the 26th of October, 1873, when her age was recorded as 74 years. See 4.13 for details of her descendants.

4.II.2.I Thomas Corlett (1418) was born circa 1795, probably in Lonan. He married Judith Lawson on the 21st of July, 1827, at Lonan. He died before 1833. See 4.13 for details of his descendants.

4.II.3 Margaret Lawson (1409) was baptized on the 20th of February, 1803, at Lonan. She married William Corkill on the 4th of June, 1826, at Braddan.

She received 1/- in her father's Will of 1833. In 1841 she and her two daughters were living in Back Bond Stret when she was employed as a charwoman. she possibly appears in the 1851 census at 3, Alms House Lane, Douglas, when she is listed as a widow, 48 years old, a washerowman, born in Lonan. It is not clear from the census whether or not she was receiving alms. Some of the other entries for Alms House Lane specifically state "alms woman".

4.11.3.1 William Corkill (1419) was born circa 1792. He married Margaret Lawson on the 4th of June, 1826, at Braddan. He died of cholera and was buried at Lonan on 4th of September, 1832.

4.11.4 John Lawson (1410) was baptized on the 25th of May, 1806, at Lonan. He married Eleanor Hogg on the 23rd of January, 1831, at Lonan (see Volume III, 20.9.3). He was a miner at the Laxey lead mines. He received 1/- in his father's Will of 1833. In 1841 he and his family were living at Laxey Glen. In 1851 and 1861 the family were living at Rehn Cell, Laxey. In 1871, a widower, he was living at 13, Rincel Road, with his unmarried son, Thomas. He was buried at Lonan on the 20th of October, 1874. See 4.16 for details of his descendants.

His MI in Laxey Old Yard (T7) states that he died on 12th of October, 1874, aged 69 years. His wife Ellinor died on the 8th of November 1868 aged 61. The following children are also mentioned:—Ann, John, Jemima Jane, Ellinor and Jane.

The MI indicates that Jane died on the 31st of May, 1888, aged 56, which would make her year of birth 1832. This person has not yet been positively identified.

4.12.1 Jane Kaighin (6657) was baptized on the 14th of May, 1826, at St. George, Douglas. She was living with her parents in Society Lane in 1841, aged 15.

4.12.2 Thomas Kaighen (6658) was baptized on the 4th of March, 1829, at St. Matthew, Douglas. He did not survive infancy and was buried on the 29th of July, 1829, at Braddan when his age was recorded as 5 months.

4.13.1 Jane Corlett (1881) was born in 1829 at Ramsey (her age is given as 11 years in the 1841 census when she was living with her widowed mother). No further details available.

4.13.2 Robert Corlett (1811) was born in 1831 at Ramsey. In 1841 he is living with his widowed mother at Laxey Glen, when his age is given as 9 years. In 1851 he is still living with his mother, at Reyn Cell, Laxey, and he is described as an unmarried mining labourer, aged 19 and born in Ramsey. He married Ann Mylroie (see 9.20.1) on the 3rd of July, 1856, at Lonan. In 1861 he is living near Laxey Mines with his wife and children and is now described as a lead miner. In 1871 the family were living at 77, Laxey Glen. In 1881 the family were living at Orry's Mount. See 4.14 for details of his descendants. In 1891 the family were living at King Orry's, Laxey.

4.14.1 Leanora Anne Corlett (2693) was baptized on the 20th of September, 1857, at Lonan. In 1871 she was living with her parents at 77, Laxey Glen. She did not survive childhood and was buried at Lonan on the 2nd of January, 1873, when her age was recorded as 15 years.

4.14.2 Emily Jane Corlett (2694) was baptized on the 10th of June, 1860, at Lonan. In 1871 she was living with her parents at 77, Laxey Glen. She was buried at Lonan on the 25th of September, 1878, when her age was recorded as 18 years.

4.14.3 Thomas A Corlett (2775) was born circa 1863, at Laxey. In 1871 he was living with his parents at 77, Laxey Glen. In 1881 he was living with his parents at Orry's Mount and was described as a pupil teacher. In 1891 he was living, unmarried, with his parents at King Orry's, Laxey, and employed as a teacher in the elementary school.

He was buried at Lonan on the 7th of April, 1952, when his age was recorded as 82 years and his residence as Orry's Mount, King Orry, Laxey.

4.14.6 Wilfred Lawson Corlett (2778) was baptized on the 20th of April, 1873, at Lonan. In 1881 he was living with his parents at Orry's Mount. In 1891 he was living, unmarried, with his parents at King Orry's, Laxey, and employed as a teacher in the elementary school. In 1901 he and his family were living at Four Roads, Rushen, where he was employed as a school teacher.

At some time he moved to Rushen where he married Christine ... There were at least three children of the marriage, all born at 4 Roads, Rushen: Nora, 1895; Frederick, 1897; and Harold, 1899. He was buried at Rushen on the 1st of September, 1965.

4.16.1 James Lawson (1423) was baptized on the 9th of June, 1833, at Lonan. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Laxey Glen. In 1851 he was living with his parents at Reyn Cell and working as a labourer at the Laxey lead mines. He married Mary Mylroie on the 8th of June, 1854, at Lonan. In both the 1861 and 1871 census he is described as a miner. In 1881 he was living with his wife and two children at 14, Glen Road, Laxey. He was buried on the 2nd of June, 1888, at Lonan, See 4.17 for details of his descendants.

4.16.1.1 Mary Ann Mylroie (1429) was born in 1834 at Lonan. She married James Lawson on the 8th of June, 1854, at Lonan. She has not been positively identified in the 1841 or 1851 census. She was buried on the 12th of June, 1888, at Lonan, just ten days after her husband. See 4.17 for details of her descendants.

4.16.2 Ann Lawson (1424) was baptized on the 13th of March, 1836, at Lonan. She was buried at Lonan on the 10th of December, 1837. Her name and the fact that she died on the 8th of December are recorded on her parent's MI, Lonan Old Yard, T7.

4.16.3 Eleanor Lawson (1425) was baptized on the 29th of July, 1838, at Lonan. In 1841 she was living with his parents at Laxey Glen. She was living with her parents at Rhencell in 1851. In 1861 she was living, unmarried, with her parents and employed as a dressmaker. She was buried at Lonan on the 17th of October, 1866.

Her parent's Mi indicated that she died on the 17th of October aged 28.

4.16.4 Jemima Jane Lawson (1426) was baptized on the 13th of September, 1840, at Lonan. She married William Clague (see Volume I, 7.31.2) on the 15th of April, 1869, at Lonan. She was buried at Lonan on the 11th of June, 1872. See Volume I, 7.317.32 for details of her descendants.

In 1841 she was living with her parents at Laxey Glen. In 1851 she was living with her parents at Reyn Cell. In 1861 she was living with her parents and employed as a milliner.

She is mentioned on two MIs at Lonan Old Yard (T7 and T12). T7 is the memorial to her parents. T12 is her own memorial on which her husband and three children are mentioned.
