## 9.1 KEWIN, KEOWN

9.1.1 The names Kew(i)n and Keown are derived from the gaelic Mac Eoin, the son of John. The name is prevalent in the north of the Island.

## 9.2 PATTRICK KEWIN—1612

9.2.1 Patrick Kewin (320) was baptized in 1612 at Jurby. He married Joney Clucas in 1631 at Jurby.

9.2.2 Jony Clucas (383) was born circa 1615, probably at Jurby. She married Patrick Kewin in 1631 at Jurby.

9.2.3 Bahee Kewn (382) was born circa 1640 in Jurby, the daughter of Patt and Joney Kewin. She married Richard Lawson on the 1st of July, 1656, at Jurby.

In November, 1698, she was a beneficiary under the Will of ... Christian, wife of Daniel Christian. Bahee died in June 1703, and her Will, by affirmation, states that she was buried on the 8th of June at Andreas. See 1.18 for details of her descendants.

9.4.1 Ann Bannan (2272) was baptized on the 25th of March, 1800, at Andreas. She married John Quayle on the 14th of October, 1820, at Lezayre.

9.4.2 Andrew Bannan (2273) was baptized on the 25th of September, 1803, at Andreas. At the census of 1841 he is living with his widowed mother at Tatterwill, Lezayre, and, although no record of a marriage has not been found, his son, Andrew, aged nine is living with them. Both are employed as agricultural labourers. In 1851 he is employed on the farm of John Fargher at Ballaspar, German. Andrew died in 1855 and was buried on the 2nd of November at Jurby.

9.4.2.1 Andrew Bannan (2290) was born circa 1831. No baptism has been found, but he is listed in 1841 census. In 1851 he is employed as a farm labourer on the farm of Jane Kelly at Lhergy Churny, Lezayre. In 1861 he is employed as a carter on the farm of Robert Allen at Ballaninney, Andreas.

9.4.3 Elizabeth Bannan (2274) was baptized on the 31st of March, 1805, at Andreas. In 1841 she is living with her widowed mother at Tatterwill, Lezayre, and is employed as a teacher. In 1851 she appears to be lodging with Catherine Christian at Cray,

Andreas (together with a possible illegitimate daughter Mary Kissack aged two) when she is described as a pauper. In 1861 she is living at Clow-e-Cleator, Andreas, again described as a pauper.

9.4.4 Jane Bannan (2275) was baptized on the 16th of November, 1806, at Andreas. No further details are available.

9.4.5 Daniel Bannan (2276) was baptized on the 2nd of October, 1808, at Andreas. He married firstly Margaret Mylrea on the 12th of April, 1834, at Jurby and secondly Jane Cleator (see Volume IV, 12.30.1) on the 14th of June 1846, also at Jurby. Daniel died in 1879 and was buried on the 23rd of May at Jurby when his age was recorded as 70 years. See 9.5 and 9.6 for details of his descendants.

In 1841 Daniel is living with his first wife and their family at Ballamoar, Jurby. He is described as a shoemaker. Living with the family is Mary Mylrea aged seventy-two, a pauper. This is possibly his mother-in-law.

In 1851 we find him living at the Curragh, Jurby with his second wife and their families. Daniel is now described as a labourer. In 1861 he and his family are living at a cottage on Close Curragh. Daniel is now described as farming 7 acres and a labourer.

9.4.5.1 Margaret Mylrea (2278) was baptized on the 27th of April, 1806, at Ballaugh, the daughter of J. Mylrea and E. Corlett. She married Daniel Bannan on the 2nd of October, 1808, at Andreas. She was buried on the 25th of May, 1845. at Ballaugh when her age was recorded as 37 years. See 9.5 for details of her descendants.

At the census of 1841 she is living with her family at Ballamoar, Jurby. Living with them is Mary Mylrea aged seventy-two, a pauper.

- 9.8.1 Ann Cowell (1813) was baptized on the 18th of July, 1819, at Lonan.
