

The Killip Family

William Killip married Ann Lawson circa 1670. Continued from Volume II, 1.17.4 and see 21.1.1 below.

Joney Killip married Robert Crow on the 13th of May, 1744, at Santan. Continued from 18.2.1 and see 21.11.1 below.

Catherine Killip married Robert Crow 9th November, 1756. Continued from 18.2.1 and see 21.11.3 below (a Corkish line).

Isabel Killip married William Kinrade on the 24th of February, 1770, at Marown. Neither identified as yet.

Mary Killip married John Cowley on the 22nd of May, 1798, at Jurby. Continued from 16.19.1 and see ... below. Their grand-daughter married James Lawson, see Volume II, 1.29.5

Catherine Killip married John Kewley on the 25th of April, 1808, at Marown.

Isabella Killip married Robert Clague on the 16th of December, 1843. Continued from Volume I, 7.10.2 and see 21.6.3 below.

Elleanor Killip married John Clague on the 10th of November, 1842. Continued from Volume I, 7.10.3 and see 21.6.4 below.

William Killip married Margaret Caley on the 18th of January, 1847, at Lezayre. Their daughter married John Kinread in 1881. Continued from 12.11.1 and see 21.13.2 below.

21.1 WILLIAM KILLIP—1645

21.1.1 William Killip (1866) was born circa 1645. He married Ann Lawson (see Volume II, 1.17.4) circa 1670. William was alive in 1692 when his son John reached his

majority and released William from any indebtedness arising from his mother's Will. See 21.2 for details of his descendants.

21.2.1 John Killip (1867) was born circa 1670. Together with his brother, he was appointed administrator of his mother's estate in 1774. In December 1692 he reached his majority and formally acknowledged that he was fully satisfied for the goods from his mother's estate and released his father from his pledge.

21.2.2 Thomas Killip (1868) was born circa 1672. Appointed joint administrator with his brother of his mother's estate, he probably died before December 1692 at which time his brother is described as "the surviving administrator".

21.3 JOHN KILLIP—1750

21.3.1 John Killip was born circa 1750, possible the son of John Killip & Jane Corkill, baptized 21st November, 1749, at Lezarye. He married Eleanor Craine on the 28th of January, 1775, at Ballaugh

21.3.2 Eleanor Craine was born circa 1750. She married John Killip on the 28th of January, 1775, at Ballaugh.

21.4.1 Mary Killip (2709) was baptized on the 1st of May, 1776, at Jurby. She married John Cowley on the 22nd of May, 1798, at Jurby. She was buried on the 26th of June, 1866, at Jurby when her age was recorded as 90 years. See 16.20 for details of her descendants.

In 1841 she was farming at Cronk Breck. Her age was given as 75 years though it was nearer 65. Her son John and two grand-children were on the farm. In 1851, a widow, she was farming 113 acres at Cronk Breck, Jurby with her son John and his wife, her widowed daughter and several grand-children. In 1861 she is still head of household at Cronk Breck. Her two widowed children, John and Catherine, are living with her together with several grand-children.

21.4.2 John Killip was baptized on the 7th of March, 1779, at Jurby. He did not survive infancy.

21.4.3 Jon Killip was baptized on the 20th of March, 1782, at Jurby.

21.4.4 Catherine Killip was baptized on the 12th of December, 1784, at Jurby.

21.4.5 Eleanor Killip was baptized on the 6th of May, 1787, at Jurby.

21.5 PATRICK KILLIP—1784

21.5.1 Patrick Killip (424) was born circa 1789 (from census data). A farmer, he married Isabella Moore (see Volume I, 13.3.1) on the 21st of January, 1807, at Lonan. He was buried at Lonan on the 28th of July, 1859, when his age was given as 75 years. See 21.6 for details of his descendants.

21.5.1.1 In 1841 he and his family were living and farming at Ballacojeen, Lonan. Margaret Quayle, aged 3 months, was living with family. In 1851 he and his wife were living at Laxey Hill. At this time he was described as "a landed proprietor of 43 acres".

21.6.1 Margaret Killip (4927) was baptized on the 17th of November, 1809, at Lonan. She married William Quayle on the 16th of January, 1836, at Lonan. Her first child was born at Lonan in December, but the family must have moved to Lezayre shortly afterwards to the Quayle family farm at Ballaskilla, Lezayre. Margaret was buried on the 28th of March, 1899, at Lezayre when her age was recorded as 89 years and her residence as Clos-e-Volley, Sulby.

21.6.1.1 William Quayle was born circa 1810 at Lezayre. He married Margaret Killip on the 16th of January, 1836, at Lonan. By 1841 the family had moved to Lezayre where William was farming at Ballaskilla. He was buried at Lezayre on the 27th of April, 1861, when his age was recorded as 50 years. [Possibly move to Volume IV-Quayle]

21.6.2 Jane Killip (4928) was baptized on the 3rd of April, 1814, at Lonan. She married William Mylrea on the 27th of January, 1838, at Lonan. She was buried at Lonan on the 25th of March, 1879, at which time her residence was recorded as "Mylrea's Terrace, Laxey Glen".

21.6.2.1 William Mylrea was baptized on the 15th of September, 1811, at Lonan, the son of William Mylrea & Ann Faragher, who married on the 13th of July, 1804, at Lonan. He married Jane Killip on the 27th of January, 1838, at Lonan.

In 1841 he was described as "hatter" and was living with his family at Laxey Glen. His brother, Thomas, was living with the family. In 1851 he and his family were living at Laxey Glen at which time he was described as "landed proprietor". In 1861 the family were farming at South Baldrine. In 1871 the family were living at 72, Laxey Glen, and William is once again employed as an hatter. In 1881, a widower, he was living at 3, Glen Road, with two of his unmarried sons. He was described as "retired farmer". He was buried on the 6th of January, 1883, at Lonan, when his age was recorded as 71 years.

21.6.3 Isabella Killip (107) was baptized on the 1st of January, 1817, at Lonan. She married Robert Clague (see Volume I, 7.10.2) on the 16th of December, 1843, at Lonan. Isabella died in 1885. She was buried with her infant daughter, Rebecca. The gravestone gives her date of death as the 13th August, 1885 at the age of sixty-eight. However, the Lonan burial register give her date of burial as 21st of August, 1885. See Volume I, 7.11 for details of her descendants.

In 1841 she was living with her parents at Ballacojeen, Lonan.

21.6.4 Eleanor Killip (309) was baptized on the 8th of February, 1822, at Lonan. In 1841 she was living with her parents at Ballacojeen, Lonan. She married John Clague (see Volume I, 7.10.3) on the 10th of November, 1842, at Lonan. She was buried at Lonan on the 8th of March, 1876, when her age was recorded as 55 years. See Volume I, 7.15 for details of her descendants.

21.6.5 Sophia Killip (427) was baptized on the 10th of April, 1825, at Lonan. In 1841 she was living with her parents at Ballacojeen, Lonan. She married William Kelly on the 9th of November, 1847, at Lonan.

21.6.5.1 William Kelly was born circa 1821 at Lonan. (son of Thomas Kelly & Elinor) In 1841 he was living with his parents at Agneash. A miner, he married Sophia Killip on the 9th of November, 1847, at Lonan. In 1851 he and his family were living at Laxey Hill. The family have not been found in the 1861 census.

21.7.1 John James Quayle was baptized on the 1st of December, 1836, at Lonan. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Ballaskelly, Lezayre.

21.7.2 William Quayle was baptized on the 9th of September, 1838, at Lezayre. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Ballaskelly, Lezayre. In 1851 he was living with his parents at Ballaskella, Lezayre.

21.8.1 Ann Mylrea was baptized on the 4th of November, 1838, at Lonan. In 1841 and 1851 she was living with her parents at Laxey Glen.

21.8.2 Thomas Mylrea was baptized on the 20th of January, 1841, at Lonan. In 1841 and 1851 he was living with his parents at Laxey Glen.

21.8.3 Jane Mylrea was baptized on the 13th of February, 1843, at Lonan. In 1851 she was living with her parents at Laxey Glen.

- 21.11.1 Joney Killip (5863) was born circa 1717 (could the baptism for Deborah in the IGI be a poor transcription?). She married Robert Crow (see 18.2.1) on the 13th of May, 1744, at Santan. She died in 1756 probably as the result of complications following childbirth as she was buried at Santan on the 17th of April, 1756, the same day as her youngest child, Thomas (later described as an idiot), was baptized. See 18.3 for details of her descendants.

She died intestate and in the Court Decree mention is made of Thomas and Philip Killip as being Uncles to Joney's children.
