6.1 JOHN CORKISH — 1780

6.1.1 John Corkish (3043) has not been positively identified. He was born circa 1780. He married Anne Lewney on the 7th of May, 1803, at Braddan. See 6.2 for details of his descendants.

6.1.2 Anne Lewney (3044) has not been positively identified. She was born circa 1780. She married John Corkish on the 7th of May, 1803, at Braddan. There is a burial for Ann Corkish on the 23rd of February, 1830, at German. No age or alias given. See 6.2 for details of her descendants.

The MI in the Braddan Old Yard, South 58, records the death of John Henry Corkish also John & Ann Corkish. It states John died in January of 1808 aged 9 months, Mary Ann died January 1808 aged 3 years and 1 month.

John Henry would appear to refer to 3047 (buried 10/12/1808) and Mary Ann to 3046 (buried 23/12/1808). John aged 9 months would seem to refer to a previously unidentified infant (5934).

John & Ann Corkish could refer to the parents, 3043 & 3044.

6.2.1 Margaret Corkish (3045) was baptized on the 8th of April, 1804, at Braddan. She married Robert Fayle on the 20th of August, 1825, at German. See 6.3 for details of her descendants.

In 1841—51 she was living with her family at the Strand, Peel. In 1861 the family were living at Shore Road, Peel. In 1871, a widow, she was living at 7, Factory Lane. There is a burial at German on the 3rd of July, 1885, for Margaret Fayle aged 80. However, so far no entry has been found in the 1881 census for any Margaret Fayle older than 69 years.

- 6.2.1.1 Robert Fayle (5933) was born circa 1795. A shoemaker. Living at The Strand, Peel, in 1841 with his wife and family. Also at The Strand in 1851. Living at Shore Road with wife and family in 1861. He was buried on the 23rd of February, 1870, at German when his age was recorded as 73 years. See 6.3 for details of his descendants.
- 6.2.2 Mary Ann Corkish (3046) was baptized on the 1st of December, 1805, at Braddan. She did not survive childhood and was buried at Braddan on the 23rd of December, 1808, just two week after her younger brother.
- 6.2.3 John Corkish (5934) was born in April of 1807 (MI). Although the MI refers to his death in January of 1808 aged 8 months a burial record has not been found at Braddan or St. George.
- 6.2.4 John Henry Corkish (3047) was baptized on the 24th of April, 1808, at Braddan. He did not survive infancy and was buried at Braddan on the 10th of December, 1808.
- 6.2.5 William Corkish (3048) was baptized on the 8th of October, 1812, at St. George, Douglas. He married firstly Isabella Cowin on the 26th of January, 1834, at Patrick, and secondly Elizabeth Clark (see 10.46.510.43.5 on the 4th of April, 1874, at Malew. William died before the census of 1891 but so far no burial record has been found. See 6.4 and 6.5 for details of his descendants.

In 1841 William was living at Barrule, Malew, with his family and was employed as an agricultural labourer. In 1851 he and his family were living on Barrule Farm, Malew, when he was employed as a lead miner. In 1861 he and his wife Isabella were living on Abbey Common, Malew, and he was still employed as a lead miner. There were no children living at home at this time. In 1871 the couple are living at 2, Stoney Mountain, Malew.

As William married a second time in April of 1874 it is assumed that Isabella died circa 1872, but so far no burial record has been found.

The 1881 census shows William & Elizabeth living at 2, Stoney Road, Malew. William is employed as a labourer at the Foxdale mines. Three sons are listed with the couple: John, 12, Robert, 10, and Daniel, 5.

John would have been born in 1868–9 when Isabella was still alive. As she would have been over 60 years old at his birth it is very unlikely that she was his mother. Likewise, Robert who would have been born in 1871. It is assumed that Elizabeth was the mother of both children and she is so described in the 1891 census. John appears in the 1871 census as boarder with Thomas & Isabella Faragher at Balla-chrink, Malew.

At the present time it is not known if John (3056) had died before the birth of the second John (3664).

- 6.2.5.1 Isabella Cowin (3050) was baptized on the 27th of May, 1804, at Onchan, the daughter of Thomas Cowin & Jane Christian. She married William Corkish on the 26th of January, 1834, at Patrick. She appears with William in the 1871 census at 2, Stoney Mountain, Malew, when her age was recorded as 60 years. She does not

appear in the 1881 census. She is presumed to have died circa 1872 but so far a burial has not been found. See 6.4 for details of her descendants.

- 6.2.5.1.1 Thomas Cowin (3051) was born circa 1770. He married Jane Christian on the 7th of June, 1803, at Andreas. In 1851, a widower, he was living with Isabella and William at Barrule, when his age was recorded as 81.
- 6.2.5.1.2 Jane Christian (3052) was born circa 1780. She married Thomas Cowin on the 7th of June, 1803, at Andreas.
- 6.2.6 Thomas Corkish (3049) was baptized on the 12th of January, 1817, at St. George, Douglas. He was buried at Braddan on the 24th of March, 1835, when his age was recorded as 18 years.
- 6.2.7 Ann Corkish (5935) was born circa 1820. A baptism has not been found but a burial is recorded at Braddan on the 2nd of April, 1821, for Ann the daughter of John & Ann Lewney.

- 6.3.1 Mary Ann Fayle was baptized on the 23rd of October, 1825, at German. In 1841 she was living with her parents at The Strand, Peel.
- 6.3.2 John Fayle was born circa 1827. In 1841 he was living with his parents at The Strand, Peel. A shoemaker like his father, he was living with his parents in 1851 at the Strand. He has not been identified in the 1861 census.
- 6.3.3 Elizabeth Fayle was born circa ca 1829. In 1841 she was living with her parents at The Strand, Peel. In 1861 she was living with her parents and employed as a general servant.
- 6.3.4 Margaret Fayle 15th of July, 1832, at German. In 1841 she was living with her parents at The Strand, Peel. In 1851 she was living with her parents at The Strand and employed as a dressmaker.
- 6.3.5 Robert Fayle was baptized on the 25th of January, 1835, at German. He did not survive childhood and was buried on the 15th of April, 1837, at Patrick when his age was recorded as 2 years.
- 6.3.6 William Fayle was baptized on the 26th of January, 1837, at German. In 1841 he was living with his parents at The Strand, Peel. In 1851 he was living with his parents at the Strand and employed as a baker.

- 6.3.7 Eleanor Fayle was born circa 1838. In 1841 she was living with her parents at The Strand, Peel.
- 6.3.8 Robert Fayle was baptized on the 1st of January, 1843, at German. In 1851 he was living with his parents at The Strand, Peel. In 1861 he was living with his parents at Shore Road and employed as a mason.
- 6.3.9 Henry Fayle was baptized on the 15th of October, 1844, at German. In 1851 he was living with his parents at The Strand, Peel. In 1861 he was living with his parents at Shore Road. He was buried at German on the 1st of June, 1864, when his age was recorded as 19 years.
- 6.3.10 James Fayle was born circa 1846. In 1851 he was living with his parents at The Strand, Peel. In 1861 he was living with his parents at Shore Road.
- 6.3.11 Edward Fayle was baptized on the 7th of September, 1849, at German. In 1851 he was living with his parents at The Strand, Peel. Not found in the 1861 census.

- 6.4.1 William Corkish (3053) was born circa 1833. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Barrule, Malew. In 1851 he was working on the farm of Richard Clucas at Kionsliew, Foxdale. He has not been identified in the 1861 or later censuses.
- 6.4.2 Elizabeth Corkish (3054) was baptized on the 18th of December, 1836, at Patrick. In 1841 she was living with her parents at Barrule, Malew. In 1851 she was working as an housemaide to John & Jane Kelly at Barrule. In 1861 she was working as a house servant for Elizabeth Goldsmith at Balladool, Lezayre. She has not been identified in the 1871 census.
- 6.4.3 Margaret Corkish (3055) was baptized on the 5th of December, 1841, at Patrick. Living with parents at Barrule in 1851. In 1861 she was employed as an house servant to Fletcher Watterson in Castletown. A possible marriage to Henry Kelly on the 15th of March, 1862, at Malew.
- 6.4.4 John Corkish (3056) was baptized on the 8th of September, 1844, at Patrick. Living with parents at Barrule in 1851. He has not been identified in the 1861 census.

6.5.1 John Corkish (3664) was baptized on the 14th of January, 1869, at Malew. Only his mother's name was given. In 1871 he was boarding with Thomas & Isabella Faragher at Ballachrink, Malew. In 1881 he was living with his parents at 2, Stoney Road, Malew. In 1891 he was living with widowed mother at 4, Stoney Road, Foxdale, when he was employed as a lead miner.

6.5.2 Robert Corkish (3665) was born circa 1871. He is not recorded in the 1871 census but is aged 10 in the 1881 census when he was living with his parents at 2, Stoney Road, Malew. In 1891 he was living with widowed mother at 4, Stoney Road, Foxdale, when he was employed as a lead miner.

6.5.3 Daniel Corkish (3666) was born circa 1875. He married Catherine Ann Radcliffe on the 20th of June, 1904, at Malew.

He was living with his parents at 2, Stoney Road, Malew, in 1881. In 1891 he was living with widowed mother at 4, Stoney Road, Foxdale, when he was employed as a labourer at the mines. In 1901 he was living, unmarried, with his mother at Stoney Mountain, Foxdale, and was employed as a lead miner.

6.6 WILLIAM CORKISH— 1788

6.6.1 William Corkish (212) was baptized on the 23rd of November, 1788, at Rushen. He was confirmed by Bishop Creggan on the 10th of August, 1803, at Malew. He married firstly Margaret Parks on the 18th of August, 1810, at Malew and secondly Isabella Simpson on the 4th of September, 1841, at Santan. He was buried at Rushen on the 18th of April, 1853.

He was a miner. Sometime between 1816 and 1821 the family moved to the parish of Marown and it was here in 1833 that Margaret died.

William Corkish, of the parish of Marown, was married for the second time on the 4th of September, 1841 at Santan Church to Isabella Simpson, see 10.29.7. William is described as a Widower of the Parish of Marown and Elizabeth is described as a Spinster of the Parish of Santan. Both made their marks. The witnesses were John Clarke (who made his mark) and Samuel Taggart. In 1851 William is still working at the Foxdale Lead Mines and living at Eairy with his wife and children. At times William has been described as a shoemaker, e.g., at the marriage of his son, John, in 1864. It was quite common for miners to have a second job. The choice of occupational description may reflect the actual economic conditions at the time. After his death in April 1853 Isabella and her son Robert Corkish (268) continue living at the same cottage. Robert is employed at the mines in Foxdale and Isabella is farming six acres.

6.6.1.1 Margaret Parks (213) was born circa 1789. She married William Corkish on the 18th of August, 1810, at Malew. See 6.7 for details of her descendants. She died in 1833 and was buried at Marown on the 26th of December.

6.7.1 Catherine Ann Corkish (263) was baptized on the 8th of September, 1811 at Braddan. She married John Hubertius Dubois on the 23rd of December, 1843, at Braddan. She appears in census for 1871 at St. James School, Patrick, but died before the census of 1881 when her husband is listed as a widower. See 6.8 for details of her descendants.

6.7.1.1 John Hubertius Dubois (276) was a schoolmaster. The census of 1851-71 give his place of birth as Ireland, but the census of 1881 gives Scotland. The censuses of 1851 and 1861 consistently provide his year of birth as 1818. It is notable that the same census gives Catherine's age as forty-four when, in fact, she would have been forty-nine. He married Catherine Corkish on the 23rd of December, 1843, at Braddan.

Hubertius Dubois taught in several schools at Douglas, Laxey and Dalby. The family is recorded in the 1871 census at Dalby, but by 1881 Hubertius had moved to England where he was living at 3, York Road, Shipton in Pocklington, Yorkshire. By this time he was a widower. His youngest daughter, Catherine, was living with him. See 6.8 for details of his descendants.

6.7.2 Charles Corkish (264) was baptized on the 14th of November, 1813 at Braddan. At the census of 1841 he was living at Ballanicholas, Marown, and was described as 25 years old labourer. He has not been found in the census for 1851 or 1861 but there is a burial for Charles Corkish aged 52 years of Dalby, Patrick, recorded at Rushen on the 22nd of August, 1866. It seems likely that Charles left the Island before 1851 (possibly for work in England) and either returned after the census of 1861 or requested that he be buried in his homeland.

6.7.3 William Corkish (265) was baptized on the 19th of May, 1816 at Braddan. He did not survive infancy and was buried on the 26th of April, 1817, at Braddan.

6.7.4 William Corkish (2082) was baptized on the 3rd of January, 1819 at Braddan. He has not been found in the 1841 census.

6.7.5 John Corkish (197) was baptized on the 5th of August, 1821 at Marown. He married firstly Elizabeth Magee on the 21st of January, 1850, at Braddan and secondly Mary McGhee 25th of September, 1864, at Braddan. See Volume V, 7.2.4 and Volume V, 7.2.7. He died on the 24th of January, 1905, and was buried at Braddan, when his age was recorded as 85 years.

His second marriage to the sister of his deceased wife was, strictly speaking, illegal, but was nonetheless a fairly common practice.

He married Elizabeth Magee at Braddan on the 21st of January, 1850, by license. At this time he is described as a weaver and was probably employed at Union Mills

Woollen Mill. He was residing in Bigwell Street. By the time of the 1851 census, John and Elizabeth are living at Ballacaine, Onchan, where their first child is born. John is again described as a weaver and is presumably working at the Bowring Mill, which was situated on Ballacain. By December, 1852, the family was living in Douglas where their second son was born and John is still described as a weaver. By November, 1855 John had left the weaving trade and is now employed as a labourer at the Howe farm. At the census in 1861 he and his family were living in Strand Street, Douglas. In July, 1861, at the birth of Frederick, the family is living at Millmount in Braddan. The family address is once again in Douglas by December, 1863 when Elizabeth dies. The movement of the family and the changes in John's occupation probably reflect the vagaries of the weaving trade. See 6.9 for details of his descendants.

In 1864 John is once again employed at the Howe farm, his address when he marries Mary McGhee. The 1871 census shows him living at 46, South Quay, Douglas, and he is described as a labourer, presumably working at the Howe farm. Mary is not listed with the family. As she was six or seven months pregnant she may have been staying with her parents. However, an Ann McGhie, a dyers assistant aged thirty-seven years, is listed and is probably a younger sister to Mary. See 6.20 for details of his descendants.

In 1881 he was living at 1, West View Lane, Douglas, with Mary and two of his children, Thomas and Margaret. He has not been found in the 1891 census but his wife, Mary, appears to be living at 14, Orry Street, a charwoman.

In 1901 he was a patient at the Poor House when he was recorded as a widower aged 79, a retired woollen dyer speaking both Manx and English.

6.7.6 Samuel Corkish (266) was baptized on the 12th of October, 1823 at Marown. In 1841 he was living with and working for John Quine of Ardenay, Onchan, when his age is given as 16. He is listed in the 1851 census as a Farm Labourer, aged twenty-four and residing at Kirby Cottage, Braddan. He married Agnes Gilleland on the 24th of December, 1859, at Braddan. The census of 1861, when he is described as a joiner, shows him living with his mother-in-law, Margaret a widow aged 60 and her family. He had died by the census of 1871. See 6.21 for details of his descendants.

6.7.6.1 Agnes Gilleland (2113) was born circa 1826 in Ireland. From the 1861 census we know that her mother's name was Margaret and that she was also born in Ireland. She married Samuel Corkish on the 24th of December, 1859, at Braddan. The 1871 census shows her living at 33, Cronkbourn, Braddan, a 40 year old widow and canvas worker. Her birth place is given as Braddan. In 1881 she is still living at 33, Cronkbourn. By 1891 she had become an inmate of the Lunatic Asylum. She died in 1892 and was buried on the 8th of June at Braddan. See 6.21 for details of her descendants.

6.7.7 Henry Corkish (2099) is assumed to have been born in January, 1829. There is a burial for Henry, son of William & Margaret Parks on the 30th of January, 1829, at Braddan. No age is given so it is assumed to be an infant burial.

6.7.8 Daniel Corkish (267) is listed in the 1841 census for Eairy Kellag. He appears to be living with his widowed father, William and his elder brother, William. Daniel is listed as being twelve years of age, which would make his year of birth 1829, and this is confirmed by the 1851 census, at which time he was described as a tailor. He has not been found in the 1861 census. No baptismal record has been found.

- 6.8.1 Margaret Dubois (324) was baptized on the 19th of September, 1845, at St. Barnabas, Douglas. She was living with her parents at the census of 1851 and 1861. She has not been found in the census of 1871 under her maiden name. No further details available.
- 6.8.2 William John Dubois (325) was baptized on the 12th of November, 1847, at St. Barnabas, Douglas. He was living with his parents at the census of 1851 and 1861 but by 1871 had left home. The census of 1881 shows him as a recently married schoolmaster living at School Cottage, Peak Forest, Derbyshire, with his wife and young son Valencia Hubert, born in May 1880. He married Catherine ... circa 1879.
- 6.8.3 Louisa Catherine Dubois (2095) was baptized on the 12th of October, 1848, at St. Barnabas, Douglas. She is not listed with the rest of the family in the 1851 census and presumably died in infancy.
- 6.8.4 Hubertius Fenton Dubois (326) was born in Laxey and baptized on the 13th of July, 1851, at Lonan. He was living with his parents at the census of 1861 and 1871. In 1881 he was an unmarried, elementary teacher living at Chester Road, Flint, Flintshire, Wales.
- 6.8.5 Catherine Louisa Dubois (327) was born in Dalby and baptized on the 24th of April, 1853, at Patrick. She was living with her parents at the census of 1861 and 1871. In 1881 she was unmarried and living with her widowed father at Shipton in Pocklington.

- 6.9.1 William Corkish (207) was baptized on the 27th of April, 1851 at Onchan. He married Catherine Mylchreest (see 19.4.6) on the 19th of November, 1871, at St. Barnabas, Douglas. He was buried at Braddan on the 19th of March, 1896, when his age was recorded as 44 years. See 6.10 for details of his descendants.

He was living with his parents in Strand Street in 1861. He was living at home (46, South Quay) in 1871, an unmarried labourer. In 1881 the family were living at 70,

Woodhouse Terrace and William was now a stationary engine driver. By 1891 the growing family had moved to 63, South Quay. William was still an engine driver.

- 6.9.2 Henry Corkish (50) was baptized on the 5th of December, 1852 at Braddan. He married Elizabeth Garret (see 10.25.3) by Banns on the 22nd of December, 1873 at the Parish Church of Liverpool. At the time of the marriage both parties gave their address as Hopwood Street, were of full age and signed the register. Henry is described as a bachelor and Fireman, the son of John Corkish, a Labourer. Henry was buried at Braddan on the 19th of December, 1926, when his age was recorded as 74 years. See 6.11 for details of his descendants.

He was living with his parents in Strand Street in 1861. In 1871 he was boarding with the Dougherty family at 22, Shaws Brow, an unmarried grocer's porter. He married in Liverpool in 1873. Some four years later the family has returned to the Isle of Man where their fourth child was born. The 1881 census shows the family living at 17, Hanover Street, Douglas, when Henry was described as a labourer. In 1891 the family were occupying 2 rooms at 12, Heywood Place. In 1901 the family were living at 25, Barrack Street.

- 6.9.3 Elizabeth Corkish (247) was born in approximately 1854. She was living with her parents in Strand Street in 1861. She has not been found in the 1871 census.

- 6.9.4 John Corkish (208) was baptized on the 4th of November, 1855, at Braddan. He was living with his parents in Strand Street in 1861. In 1871 he was living with his father at 46, South Quay, a 13 years old roper. In 1881 he was fishing on the "Romeo".

- 6.9.5 Mary Ann Corkish (248) was born in March, 1857. She died in May, 1857, aged two months.

- 6.9.6 Thomas Daniel Corkish (249) was baptized on the 28th of November, 1858, at Rushen. He was living, aged two years, with his parents in Strand Street in 1861. He probably died before 1865 when the second Thomas (218) was born, see 6.20.1 below.

- 6.9.7 Frederick Corkish (209) was baptized on the 14th of July, 1861. He was living with his father at 46, South Quay in 1871.

- 6.10.1 Henry Corkish (3622) was baptized on the 7th of June, 1874, at Braddan. Living with parents in 1881-91. He has not been identified in the 1901 census.

- 6.10.2 Herbert Jonah Corkish (3623) was born circa 1876. Living with parents in 1881–91. He was buried at Braddan on the 31st of May, 1934, when his age was recorded as 57 years. He has not been Identified in the 1901 census.
- 6.10.3 William Edward Corkish (3624) was born on the 14th of July, 1878, at Douglas. Living with parents in 1881–91. he has not been identified in the 1901 census.

- 6.II.4.1 William Saunders Corkish (7146) was born on the 10th of June, 1898, at Douglas. Only his mother's name was recorded at the registration. In 1901 he was living with his grand-parents at 25, Barrack Street.

A son is thought to have emigrated to Canada in approximately 1960, and he is believed to have married, divorced, remarried and to be residing in British Columbia. This all has to be confirmed.

- 6.II.5 Robert Henry Corkish (49) was born on the 21st of June, 1880. In 1881 he was living with his parents at 17, Hanover Street, Douglas. In 1891 he was living with his parents at 12, Heywood Place. He married Agnes Carney at St. George's Church, Douglas, on the 7th of September, 1901, at which time he gave his address as 2, Athol Square. He is described as a bachelor and a mason. His age is given as twenty-one years. His father is named as Henry Corkish, Labourer. The witnesses were John Henry Crennell and Isabella Carney, the bride's sister. See 6.12 for details of his descendants.

Robert emigrated to Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, Canada before the First World War (the exact date has not been established 1913?). Robert lived for a time with Tommy Johnson, his brother-in-law (Tommy married Isabella Carney, Agnes' sister) though it is not certain that Robert and Tommy emigrated together.

On the 29th of July, 1915 he enlisted in the 65th Overseas Battalion in Saskatoon his occupation being recorded as bricklayer. After training, he embarked on 20th of June, 1916 on the S.S. Empress of Britain, disembarking on the 28th of June. He was transferred to the 44th Battalion at Bramshott. On the 28th of November, 1916 he was transferred to France where he served with the 44th Battalion until April 1919 when he was moved to Ripon prior to being returned to Canada. During his time in France he twice served temporary assignments with the 10th Field Company, Canadian Engineers. He also attended a training course for batmen in July 1917 and was granted ten days leave in November of 1917. He was demobilized in Halifax, N.S. on the 18th of July, 1919, at which time his address is given as West Pugwash, N.S. and his trade is recorded as 'Farmer'. As a returning Canadian Veteran he was able to bring his family to Canada in the summer of 1919, only his recently married, eldest daughter, Catherine Elizabeth Corkish, remaining in the Isle of Man. The family settled in Pugwash, Nova Scotia.

Robert worked as a mason. He built the first brick house in Pugwash (was this the unfinished house he brought his family to and which his sons helped to finish?). In 1927 while working at the Doctor's house some scaffolding gave way and he suffered a bad fall. The resulting serious back injuries prevented any further work. He died in Pugwash, Nova Scotia, on the 11th May, 1934. The family home was rented out when Agnes moved to Ontario with the four youngest children, living for a while with her eldest son James. Agnes returned to the Isle of Man with the four youngest children in May, 1936 and the family home was sold some time later when the problems of renting it out from such a distance became too great.

She remained on the Isle of Man when her parents, brothers and sisters emigrated to Canada in 1919. After the death of her husband, Jimmy in March 1941, Catherine worked as a cook in the NAAFI at Jurby aerodrome. She emigrated to Canada in April 1949. Intending to settle in Ontario with her son Robert, she actually continued on to British Columbia where her brothers Bobby and Danny and her sisters Nelly and Peggy were residing. She worked for a time in a salmon canning factory at Alert Bay. She married a second time on the 5th of December, 1956 to Alphonse LeMay at Whalley, B.C. There were no issue of this second marriage. She died on the 28th of December, 1982 in a nursing home in Vancouver. She was cremated and her ashes buried in February 1983 with her father in Pugwash, Nova Scotia. See Volume III, 1.21 for details of her descendants.

[Possible son?] Bobby worked in the construction trade, living for some time at Kitimat, B.C., during the building of the aluminium smelters. He was an expert woodworker, producing many pieces of furniture for the family, mainly in cedar. Lost an eye ...? Like so many men in the construction and logging industries, Bobby alternated between periods of hard work in the camps and short sprees in the town where his hard earned money rapidly disappeared into beer. He spent the later years of his life in the Skid Road area of Vancouver. He died on the 27th of August, 1973.
- 6.12.6 Daniel John Corkish (62) was born on the 17th of August, 1910, at 4, Athol Square, off Shaw's Brow, Douglas. When just nine years old, he moved to Pugwash, N.S. with his family. On the death of his father the family home was left to Danny on the understanding that he assume the responsibility of looking after his mother and younger sisters. When his mother decided to return to the Isle of Man in May 1936, Danny accompanied her and his three youngest sisters. Danny commenced training as a nurse at Cumberland Hospital, completing his training the Braddan Hospital, he met his future wife Jane Elizabeth Bostock (Kermeen) (161), Jenny, who was also training as a nurse. They married on the 13th of November, 1937, at St. George's, Douglas. Archdeacon Stockwell officiated. They lived at Foxdale until the outbreak of war, when Daniel joined the Medical Corps, reaching the rank of Staff Sergeant. He was serving in Iraq when his mother became ill. On her second marriage to Charles Edward McCorkle (361), on the 11th of July, 1969, at Bellingham, Washington, she moved to Bellingham. She died on the 18th of September, 2003, at Bellingham.
