## 22.1 THOMAS QUORK — 1640

According to his wife's Will, he also made a Will (not yet found) in which he left 6d to his wife before he went to England. It is not clear whether this was a precautionary measure before setting sail or whether he had left the family.

22.1.2 Mary Corkish was born circa 1640. She married Thomas Quork on the 10th of June, 1662, at Malew. She died on the 5th of January, 1699, at Malew.

In 1851 she was living with her parents at Glentrammon, Lezayre, when she was employed as a farm labourer. In 1861 she was living with her parents at Vicarage Road, Lezayre, when she was employed as a dressmaker.

In 1871 he was lodging with his two young children with William Quirk, at Glebe Cottage, Lezayre. Although he is described as "lodger" he appears to be living with his younger brother and sister. His wife, Sarah Ann was an inmate of the Lunatic Asylum, Braddan.

In 1881 he is farming 12 acres at Ballacree, Lezayre, a widower with two children.

22.18.1 Thomas Quirk (6699) was baptized on the 20th of November, 1823, at Jurby. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Balla McSkelly, Andreas. In 1851 he was living on the family farm at Ballamarcheall, Andreas. He has not been identified in the 1861 census. In 1871 he was living with his father at Narradale, at which time he was described as an 'imbecile'. In 1881 he was an inmate of the General Lunatic Asylum, Braddan, at which time he was described as a sailor. In 1891, aged 72, he was a patient at the Lunatic Asylum. He was buried on the 23rd of June, 1896, at Braddan at which time his age was recorded as 79 years and his residence as Asylum.

22.18.2 John Quirk (6700) was baptized on the 6th of October, 1826, at Andreas. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Balla McSkelly, Andreas. In 1851 he appears to have been visiting James & Elizabeth Cain in Onchan at which time he was described as a journeyman joiner. He has not been identified in later censuses and there is a possible smallpox burial at Patrick on the 21st of March, 1853, for John Quirk aged 29 years.

widowed father at Narradale. She has not been identified in the 1881 census, and there is a possible burial at Jurby on 2nd of May, 1876, for Eleanor Jane aged 48 years.
